Osmotherley Parish Council - May 2024

The PC met earlier than usual and held its AGM, which elected a new Chairman and Vice Chairman for the coming year. Cllr Barrie Robinson is the new Chairman and Cllr Paul Howlett is the new Vice Chairman.

The Clerk updated the PC on the continuing Highways issues throughout the village and it was noted that the water flowing down Clack Lane has been causing issues for a resident but it was hoped that the drier weather would help. However all the water flow concerns will likely return next winter and therefore the PC confirmed it would maintain pressure on Highways to rectify as soon as possible.

The picnic tables, which were temporarily placed in front of the Three Tuns, and surplus to requirements by the owner, were removed to the village play area. The PC thanked the owner of the Three Tuns for his generosity and also Richard Horner and Trevor Swales for removing them from the parking bay.

The two vacancies on the PC will now be filled by co-opting applicants and a separate advert is included in the Messenger for any resident of Osmotherley who might be interested. Closing date: 20th June 2024.

The National Park will be undertaking a traffic management survey in the village at the end of the May to determine the need for a visitor car park. A notice from the National Park will be posted on the notice board giving more information.

The footpath and disabled access points from the road in front of the village hall were discussed and agreed to request the Caretaker to widen the footpaths as soon as possible. Three planning applications were received and discussed and it was noted that two recent applications were recommended by NYM to be refused.

Nature Notes

It is surprising how many wild flowers we have in Osmotherley, where the banks and verges have been left unmown. On a short walk along West End and Clack Bank in early May, I counted 38 different wild flowers and a good variety of hedge species. The very wet winter has resulted in an abundance of green growth. Particularly noteworthy was the white dead nettle, humming with bees but there was also Jack-by-the-hedge (or garlic mustard) which is a food plant for the orange-tip butterfly and many others. Near the bottom of Clack Bank, on the left side, you may have seen a bank of cowslips and greater stitchwort, and on closer inspection, violets nestling in the grass. In the hedge holly, wild apple, elder, blackthorn and hawthorn, all flowering in their turn if left uncut, and providing nest-sites for birds and small mammals. If you have a square of grass that can be left uncut, it will be a great help to insects, and therefore to birds, if you leave it to grow and seed before cutting. Every flower is worth looking at closely – even drab Shepherd's Purse, growing along the base of the churchyard wall. Look at its seed – tiny heart-shaped pods.
